Since our launch in 2000, we have raised many millions of pounds through tremendous public support to build Phase One. We have also raised hundreds of thousands of pounds to provide equipment and enable the first Teenage Cancer Trust unit to be built.

Our challenge now is to fund vital state-of-the-art equipment for Phase Two of the children's hospital.

Children's Hospital for Wales

At the Children's Hospital for Wales wonderful work happens each day by a first class medical team and all the people behind the scenes.

The light, bright and colourful building has been designed with children and families in mind, helping ensure that the experience of being admitted into hospital is as comfortable and supportive as possible.

Since opening in 2005, many thousands of children from all over Wales, in need of specialist medical and cancer care have been treated annually. Phase Two will ensure that children needing surgery and those in intensive-care will have the same first-rate facilities.



With your help,

we will raise a further £7m for the Children's Hospital for Wales. This will fund a number of vital projects for Phase Two, including:

- An 'open' MRI scanner
- A hydrotherapy pool
- 2 integrated theatres
- Equipment for the new paediatric critical care unit
- An enclosed garden for leisure, therapy, education and rehabilitation

We rely on the kindness of our supporters. Phase One is a magnificent achievement and without your donations it would not have been possible.

Now the work continues and we still need your support.

Phase Two will include:

- 5 children's operating theatres
- A new critical care unit to treat children needing high dependency or intensive care
- Brand new wards for children needing surgery
- A large outpatients department and dental suite
- Outpatients café
- Assessment centres
- Therapies suite

The completed hospital is expected to treat over 100,000 patients every year.
